Notes:

1. All competitors are encouraged to have a Manitoba Horse Council or other Provincial Horse Council/Federation membership for insurance protection. Competitors must have a CWHHA membership and a Provincial Horse Council/Federation membership to qualify for year-end awards. Points towards year-end awards will not accumulate for a competitor until they have paid for a membership and the competitor/horse combination must attend a minimum of three (3) shows in 2019.
2. If a competitor does not choose to become a CWHHA member, they will pay the CWHHA non-member office fee and will still require proof of their Provincial Horse Council/Federation membership. However, to encourage growth and interest in CWHHA and the local horse community, a competitor may try out, called a hometown, one CWHHA show per year without holding a Provincial Horse Council/Federation membership. Hometown competitors must sign a waiver prior to competing. Note: Claiming hometown status at a show will exempt a competitor from earning year-end points for that show, as a full membership including CWHHA and a Provincial Horse Council/Federation membership is required to obtain points.
3. MHC does waive their membership fee for lead line contestants but a membership form is still required.
4. One entry form & registration fee per Exhibitor/Rider, per show.
5. A horse can only show ONCE in any given class. i.e. said horse can be shown in midget trail and senior trail but NOT twice in midget trail.
6. Classes with 3 or less entries will be combined with another age category where possible.
7. No exhibitor cross entry with the Walk/Jog classes into the regular classes, except in speed events, regardless of horse. For example, a rider can NOT show horse A in Trail and horse B in walk/jog trail.
8. Horses competing in Walk/Jog classes may be ridden two hands in a snaffle or 1 handed in a shank bit, regardless of age.
9. Midgets and Juniors are allowed to ride with two hands in Reining, regardless of bit.
10. Please check bulletin board posted at show for FINAL CLASS SCHEDULE.
11. Full payment must be made at time of registration of the show date.
12. Show office opens 1 hour before scheduled show start time. You can also pre register up to 6:00 pm the night before.
13. CWHHA family is defined as Immediate Family Members (18 & under).
14. The Event, Class, Prizes & Awards are subject to change, modification or removal & may be cancelled at the discretion of the CWHHA Board & Show Management.
15. In stakes classes, CWHHA will keep 10% of the entry fees. The payout structure is 40% / 30% / 20% / 10%.
16. By participating in CWHHA events, all competitors agree to abide by the rules of the show and the governing bodies, AQHA and NRHA.
17. The CWHHA reserves the right to interpret these rules and regulations. All decisions by the CWHHA board will be final. By way of making an entry, the exhibitor is assuming responsibility for knowledge of the rules and releases show management from any claims or losses.

Liability

Ticket System

- You buy as many tickets as per classes that you want to go into.
- The ticket system is matched with the rider horse combination. The number you are given will be with you for the entire season. You are given the number at the time of your 1st registration. This is how year end awards are calculated so DO NOT change numbers for a horse/rider combination.
- You write your rider # on the ticket.
- Hand your ticket in to the gate person before entering the gate. No entry into class without a ticket, no exceptions!
- The tickets will be sent to the show office to get recorded down. The Ring Stewart and the Judge will record down the rider horse # of what is on your back/blanket. If you have more than 1 horse you will have to make sure the number that is on the ticket is the same number that is on your back / blanket number. The tickets will be confirmed with the list from the judge with the placements.
- The stakes class tickets will be a different color so you can tell them apart.
